Not only have he and his wife Barbara worked together on some of his books, but his two children, Rebecca + Michael, have also been collaborators on some of his illustrated book projects. He was born in Malden, but now resides in Ipswich, Massachusetts with his family, where he also enjoys running, sailing + skiing.
